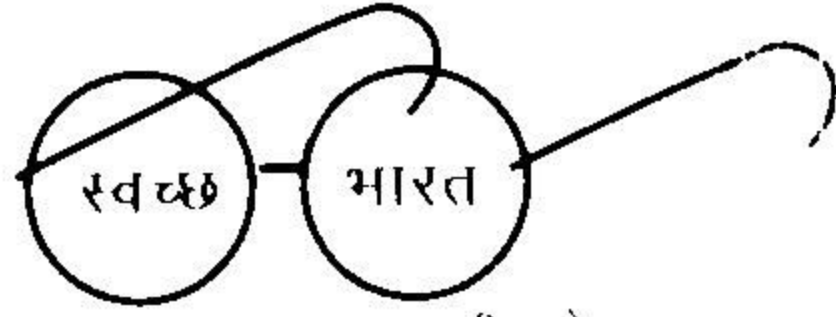

- Hardware Edition will be a 5 days long hardware product development competition


