## ADMISSION GUIDELINES FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2015-16:

#### **GUIDELINES FOR TRADITIONAL DEGREE COURSES: (I)**

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:** A)

- The Admission to T.D.C-I (all faculties) will be made purely on merit basis. Marks (i) obtained in the qualifying examination alongwith willingness, if any by the students shall be the sole criterion for admission.
- Compartment Candidates will be entertained on the last day of admission subject (ii) to availability of seats.
- Failed candidates in T.D.C-I are not allowed admission in T.D.C-I. These (iii) students may be encouraged to pursue higher education through Distance Education Programmers/Correspondence courses being offered by the State Universities, IGNOU and a large number of other Universities in the country.

#### NUMBER OF SEATS ALLOTTED: (B)

- The number of seats allotted for various streams/courses/subjects will remain the i) same in general as for the previous academic session. However, the change in number of seats, wherever applicable are annexed Annexure-A.
- Principals must ensure that rationalization of all the subjects shall be made so ii) that almost equal number of students get admissions in all the subjects.

#### Courses/Subjects introduced or discontinued. C)

The college-wise details of courses/subjects introduced or discontinued is enclosed as Annexure 'A ' & 'B'.

#### MINIMUM NUMBER OF STUDENTS TO BE ENROLLED: D)

In order to have optimum utilization of the resources and faculty, the following criterion will be adopted for enrolment of students:

### Arts Faculty:

A minimum of 40 students to be admitted for starting/ continuing a subject.

#### Commerce Faculty: i)

A minimum of 40 students to be admitted for starting/ continuing a subject.

#### Science Faculty: ii)

A minimum of 40 students to be admitted for starting/ continuing a subject.

#### iii) PG Courses

For MA-I Classes (where ever applicable) 40-60 students per subject and in case of Music 30 students need to be admitted.

#### **ELECTIVE SUBJECTS:** E)

Compulsory/Elective, Sanskrit subjects Hindi like The Compulsory/Elective, and Punjabi Compulsory/Elective should be offered only where there are a minimum of 30 students opting for each of these subjects.

It is clarified that no relaxation in the number of students will be given. The Principals are advised not to make any correspondence in this regard.

#### F) LAST DATE OF SUBJECT CHANGE:

The students may be allowed change of subject(s) within 15 days of start of regular classes or as per the Affiliating University norms.

#### **TEACHING WORKLOAD:** G)

The Principals must work out teaching workload by 30th July, 2015. College-wise schedule for submission of workload is enclosed as Annexure-III. This workload will be decided after taking into account the actual number of students attending the class in a particular subject/stream. Subject change must be taken into account while calculating / deciding the workload. It would be the



sole responsibility of the concerned Principal to ensure the exact assessment of the teaching workload. The guidelines regarding admissions issued by the Directorate from time to time alongwith the norms of University should be strictly followed. The information in enclosed proforma (students data) also be sent alongwith the workload. Above information should be in re-writable C.D. as well as in the form of hard copy.

#### **GUIDELINES FOR JOB-ORIENTED COURSES/New Courses/PG Courses:** H)

For the Job oriented courses, the minimum number of students permissible is 40. The Principal will take personal interest to see that there is required strength of PG, JOC, Science and Elective subjects upto maximum number as per norms of University/ directions from the Directorate.

## RESERVATION:

The reservation policy of the State Government regarding admissions must be strictly followed. Any violation of guidelines issued by the State Government will be viewed seriously and the Principal concerned will be held responsible for any lapse. According to the guidelines issued by the Chief Secretary vide No. 22/10/13-1 GS III dated 28-02-2013 the following reservation

is to be provided to different categories:

(F)	Physically Handicapped	3%	In the event of quota reserved for physically handicapped remain unutilized due to non availability of suitable category of handicapped candidates, it may be offered to the Ex-servicemen and their wards (1%) and the dependents of Freedom Fighter (1%).

Further, 3% Horizontal reservation is also provided to Ex-servicemen /Freedom Fighters and their dependents by providing reservation within reservation of 1% of general category, 1% out of scheduled castes and 1% from backward classes category for admissions to the various educational institutions of the Government and Government aided/institutes Located in Haryana. As far as block allocation in Block A and Block B of Backward Classes category is concerned year-wise rotational system will be adopted. For example if block of Backward classes are given seats in the academic year 2006, the next block i.e. B Block of category of Backward classes will be given seats in the next academic year i.e. 2007 and so on.

#### **GENERAL: (J)**

The common admission schedule and admission guidelines of the affiliating (i) University must be adhered to.

- (ii) Colleges are required to procure a copy of gazette from Haryana School Education Board, Bhiwani, CBSE, New Delhi and Chandigarh for the purpose of preparing merit list.
- (iii) Preference in admissions in evening classes (wherever applicable) be given to those candidates who are employed in some vocational job as per Govt. instructions on the subject(s).
- (iv) The number of students in a section will be upto 80. The composition group will be half of the section strength subject to a minimum of 40 students.
- (v) The Principals are to ensure that the tutorials should be held regularly in all classes.
- (vi) Principals shall also ensure that counselling of one week is undertaken with parents and students in the last week of June so that all their doubts and queries regarding subjects and courses are clarified. For this, necessary schedule may be prepared and published.

The Admission guidelines mentioned above must be strictly adhered to.
