5. Ensuring maximum participation of all the students in all activities and encouraging extensive dissemination through social media and local media platforms.

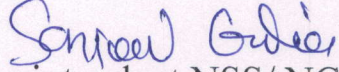

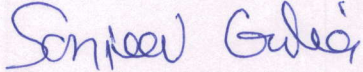

Partition Horror Remembrance Day – 2026

Concept of the Programme

Brief Outline

Partition Horror Remembrance Day shall be observed across Haryana on 14 August 2026 to commemorate the memories of those affected by the Partition of India. The observance aims to educate the younger generation about the tragic consequences of Partition while paying tribute to the courage, resilience and sacrifices of millions who endured displacement and suffering.

Plan of Action

1. The programme shall be organised at the State Level and District Level.
2. The observance shall combine remembrance, public awareness and educational activities.
3. Activities shall include exhibitions, documentary screenings, theatrical performances, experience sharing, candlelight tributes and educational outreach.

Main Programme – State Level

Brief Outline

The State-level function shall be organised at Indradhanush Auditorium, Sector-5, Panchkula, under the leadership of the Hon'ble Chief Minister. Families of Partition survivors may also be invited, subject to feasibility. Keeping in view the solemn nature of the occasion, the venue shall have a dignified ambience with white-themed decorations, white floral arrangements and a two-minute silence as an integral part of the programme.

Plan of Action

1. The State-level programme shall be organised on 14 August 2026 at Indradhanush Auditorium, Panchkula.
2. White-themed venue decoration, white floral arrangements and other ceremonial arrangements shall be made befitting the solemnity of the occasion.
3. A two-minute silence shall be observed as part of the programme.
4. Necessary seating, protocol and logistical arrangements shall be ensured.

Stage–I : Exhibition & Short Film Screening

Brief Outline

An exhibition on Partition Horror Remembrance Day shall be organised from 13 August 2026 at the main venue to educate visitors, particularly school children, about the historical events associated with Partition. Documentary films depicting various aspects of Partition shall complement the exhibition.

Plan of Action

1. The exhibition shall be established from 13 August 2026 at Indradhanush Auditorium, Panchkula.
2. Exhibition material shall be arranged in consultation with the Department of Culture, Government of India.
3. Curated visits of school children shall be organised on 13 August.
4. Documentary films downloaded from amritkal.nic.in/partition-horror-remembrance-day shall be screened.
5. Suggested films include:
 - *The New Post Box*
 - *Chan Kithan: The Derawalas and Partition*
 - *Partition and Matua Community and Partition*
6. Film screenings shall be organised during student visits on 13 August and, if feasible, before the main programme on 14 August.
7. Publicity shall be taken as per requirement for the event.

Stage–II : Play on Partition

Brief Outline

A theatrical presentation depicting the human experiences and emotional impact of Partition shall form an important cultural component of the State-level programme.

Plan of Action

1. The approved script provided by the Ministry of Culture shall be adopted.
2. The reference recording provided by the Ministry shall be utilised for rehearsals.
3. The Department of Art & Culture shall arrange artists and stage production.
4. Necessary stage, sound and lighting arrangements shall be finalised before the programme.

Director General, Art & Culture, IPRL

Stage–III : Experience Sharing & Addresses

Brief Outline

The programme shall provide an opportunity for representatives of families affected by Partition to share their experiences, thereby preserving oral history and enabling younger generations to understand the human dimensions of Partition.

Plan of Action

1. Deputy Commissioners shall identify suitable families affected by Partition in consultation with the Rehabilitation Branch and forward one or two significant stories.
2. Selected stories shall be narrated by the anchor during the programme.
3. Representatives from the affected families may share their personal experiences.
4. The programme shall be followed by the addresses of the Hon'ble Governor and Hon'ble Chief Minister.

Conclusion of the Main Programme

Brief Outline

The State-level programme shall conclude with a solemn candlelight tribute and silent march symbolising collective remembrance and respect for those affected by Partition.

Plan of Action

1. The dignitaries shall light candles outside the main auditorium while exiting the programme.
2. A suitable location shall be identified near the exit for commencement of the tribute.
3. The silent candle march shall proceed from Indradhanush Auditorium to Yavanika Town Park.
4. A Wall of Remembrance shall be created at the culmination point where participants shall pay floral and candle tributes.
5. Police and Traffic authorities shall ensure uninterrupted movement, while arrangements for drinking water, first aid and crowd management shall also be ensured.

District Level Programmes

Brief Outline

1. Commemorative programmes shall be organised in schools, colleges, universities and other public institutions.
2. Lectures, discussions, exhibitions and documentary screenings shall be organised to promote awareness about the history and significance of Partition.
3. Schools, colleges and universities shall encourage students to participate in the National Online Quiz on Partition Horror Remembrance Day to be organised on the MyGov Portal from 1 August to 15 September 2026.
4. District administrations shall ensure wide publicity and participation in all commemorative activities.

Har Ghar Tiranga Campaign - 2026 Concept Note

The **Har Ghar Tiranga Campaign 2026** will be observed across Haryana from **9th to 17th August 2026**. This year's campaign commemorates **150 Years of Vande Mataram** and aims to strengthen citizens' emotional connect with the National Flag through coordinated public participation across the State.

The campaign envisages a coordinated, whole-of-government approach involving all Departments, educational institutions, local bodies and civil society through cultural programmes, public outreach, digital engagement and community participation.

The major components of the campaign are as follows:

1. **State-Level Launch** through a Press Conference highlighting the campaign roadmap and activities.
2. **Vande Mataram-themed Patriotic Tiranga Concert** featuring patriotic performances and mass singing of the official version of *Vande Mataram*.
3. **Tiranga & Vande Mataram Exhibitions** at the State, District, Block, Panchayat and educational institution levels.
4. **Tiranga Bike, Cycle & E-Bike Rallies** and **District-level Tiranga Processions** across the State.
5. **Digital Campaign – Selfie with Tiranga** through dedicated selfie points and social media outreach.
6. **Tricolour Lighting and Decoration** of Government buildings and prominent public places.
7. **Large-scale Tricolour Rangoli** on patriotic and *Vande Mataram* themes.
8. **Planning, Procurement and Distribution of National Flags** to ensure adequate availability across the State.

Successful implementation requires close coordination among all concerned Departments under the overall supervision of the Deputy Commissioners. The detailed action plan assigns department-wise responsibilities for effective implementation of the campaign across Haryana.

Har Ghar Tiranga Campaign-2026

- This year Har Ghar Tiranga will be celebrated from 9th to 17th August 2026.
- Har Ghar Tiranga 2026 celebrations and activities will commemorate 150 Years of Vande Mataram.
- Physical programmes conducted during this period may include the singing of Vande Mataram.
- Ministry of Home Affairs has issued guidelines for the singing of 'Vande Mataram'.

Press Conference by State

1. Outline of the Press Conference

- The State Government shall organise a press conference before the commencement of the Har Ghar Tiranga campaign.
- The press conference shall highlight the key activities and programmes being undertaken under Har Ghar Tiranga 2026 across the State.
- The briefing shall cover activities of various Departments, Schools & Colleges, Corporates, Civil Society Organizations, Tiranga Lighting & Decoration initiatives, and the State-level event.
- The objective shall be to ensure coordinated dissemination of information and wide public outreach through print, electronic and digital media.

2. Plan of Action

1. The Department of Public Relations shall consolidate the details of the entire programme from all concerned Departments.
2. A brief outline and media brief for the press conference shall be prepared by the Department of Public Relations.
3. The date and time of the press conference shall be finalised in consultation with the Office of the Hon'ble Chief Minister.
4. Necessary media coordination, invitations, press kits and publicity arrangements shall be undertaken by the Department of Public Relations.

3. Action to be Taken

Necessary action shall be taken by the Director General, Information, Public Relations, Languages & Culture (DG IPRL).

Vande Mataram Themed Patriotic Tiranga Concert

1. Outline of the Patriotic Tiranga Concert

- A State-level Patriotic Tiranga Concert dedicated to the spirit of Vande Mataram.
- It will be a concert featuring a patriotic line-up of songs.
- It is proposed to be held in the VVIP presence of the Hon'ble Chief Minister and Hon'ble Governor.
- Mass singing of the official version of Vande Mataram shall be made a part of the Tiranga Concert-based event.

2. Plan of Action

1. The proposed venue shall be Yavnika Garden, Sector-5, Panchkula.
2. The Department of Art and Culture shall make the necessary arrangements for the concert.
3. Artists capable of performing patriotic songs, including a few songs with a local patriotic touch, shall be engaged.
4. Pamphlets of the official version of the Vande Mataram song shall be printed by the Print Section of DIPRL and distributed before the concert so that participants can sing along. Mass singing of the official version of Vande Mataram shall form an integral part of the Tiranga Concert-based event& branding for the concert be done by IPRL Deptt.

Tiranga and Vande Mataram Exhibition

1. Outline of the Exhibition

- Like every year, a special exhibition on Tiranga and Vande Mataram may be curated.
- The exhibition may be set up at the entrance of the concert venue to enable visitors to view it.
- Upon the arrival of the Chief Guest, a guided tour of the exhibition may be organised.

2. Plan of Action

1. The exhibition may be organised around the entrance of Yavnika Garden, Sector-5, Panchkula, where the Patriotic Tiranga Concert is proposed to be held.
2. The stalls, tentage and exhibition space shall be arranged by the Department of Art and Culture, which is also making arrangements for the concert.
3. The Exhibition Section of the Department of Public Relations shall make arrangements for the display. If required, an agency may be engaged for arranging the display stands.
4. The exhibition material shall be arranged in coordination with the Department of Culture, Government of India.
5. All other necessary supporting arrangements shall be made by the local administration.

3. Action to be Taken

Necessary action shall be taken by the Director General, Information, Public Relations, Languages & Culture (DG IPRL), the Department of Art and Culture, and the Deputy Commissioner, Panchkula.

Tiranga and Vande Mataram Exhibition Display (District Level)

1. Outline of the Programme

- Based on material received from the Department of Culture, Government of India, Tiranga and Vande Mataram exhibitions shall be organised across the State.
- The exhibitions shall be organised at the District, Block and Panchayat levels at prominent public places.
- Schools, colleges and universities shall organise exhibitions highlighting the evolution of the National Flag and the spirit of Vande Mataram.
- Community participation shall be encouraged through student-led walkthroughs and outreach activities.

2. Plan of Action

1. Based on material received from the Department of Culture, Government of India, exhibitions shall be organised at the District, Block and Panchayat levels and displayed at shopping malls, railway stations, city parks and during District, Block and Panchayat-level Independence Day programmes.

2. The Department of Urban Local Bodies, through Municipal Corporations and Municipal Councils, shall arrange exhibitions at shopping malls, railway stations and city parks. At the Block and Panchayat levels, the concerned BDPOs shall organise the exhibitions under the overall supervision of the concerned Deputy Commissioner.

3. The School Education Department, Higher Education Department and Universities shall organise Tiranga and Vande Mataram exhibitions in halls, libraries and auditoriums. Student volunteers shall conduct walkthroughs, while Deputy Commissioners shall coordinate with NGOs and RWAs to extend the campaign beyond campuses.

3. Action to be Taken

Necessary action shall be taken by the Additional Chief Secretary, Urban Local Bodies; Additional Chief Secretary, Panchayati Raj; Additional Chief Secretary, School Education; Additional Chief Secretary, Higher Education; Vice-Chancellors of the Universities; and all Deputy Commissioners.

Tiranga Bike, Cycle & E-Bike Rallies

1. Outline of the Programme

- Tiranga Bike, Cycle and E-Bike Rallies shall be organised across the State to promote public participation in the Har Ghar Tiranga campaign.
- The rallies shall ensure participation from youth, educational institutions, sports organisations and local communities.
- Routes shall be planned to maximise public visibility while ensuring safety and smooth traffic management.

2. Plan of Action

1. All Deputy Commissioners shall organise Tiranga Bike, Cycle and E-Bike Rallies at the District Headquarters and Gram Panchayat levels. Participation may be mobilised through the Department of Sports, NCC, NSS, youth clubs, Resident Welfare Associations and NGOs. Coordination at the Gram Panchayat level shall be undertaken through the concerned BDPOs in coordination with the Gram Panchayats.
2. The routes shall be finalised by the Deputy Commissioners so that the rallies pass through prominent public places, freedom fighter memorials and designated selfie points to maximise public outreach and visibility.
3. The District Police and local traffic authorities shall ensure participant safety and smooth traffic management with minimum disruption to the public. Adequate first-aid, drinking water and emergency response arrangements shall also be made along the route.

3. Action to be Taken

Necessary action shall be taken by the Additional Chief Secretary, Sports; Additional Chief Secretary, Home; Additional Chief Secretary, Panchayati Raj; Additional Chief Secretary, School Education; Additional Chief Secretary, Higher Education; Director General of Police; and all Deputy Commissioners.

Tiranga Rallies (Procession)

1. Outline of the Programme

- District-level Tiranga Rallies (Processions) shall be organised across the State.
- The rallies shall feature participants carrying the National Flag in accordance with the Flag Code of India.
- Mass singing of Vande Mataram may be organised at the commencement of the rally.
- The rallies shall encourage participation of students, youth, Government officials, CAPFs, Police personnel and community organisations to promote patriotism, national unity and pride.

2. Plan of Action

1. All Deputy Commissioners shall organise Tiranga Rallies at the District Headquarters. Participation may be mobilised through Government Departments, educational institutions, NCC, NSS, Bharat Scouts & Guides, Resident Welfare Associations, NGOs and other community organisations.
2. The District Police and local traffic authorities shall ensure adequate security, traffic regulation and emergency response arrangements. Drinking water, first-aid and public announcement facilities shall also be provided to facilitate the smooth conduct of the rallies.

3. Action to be Taken

Necessary action shall be taken by the Additional Chief Secretary, Sports; Additional Chief Secretary, Home; Additional Chief Secretary, School Education; Additional Chief Secretary, Higher Education; Director General of Police; and all Deputy Commissioners.

Digital Activity – Selfie with Tiranga

1. Outline of the Programme

- Selfie with Tiranga shall be promoted as a key digital activity under the Har Ghar Tiranga campaign.
- Keeping in view the 150th year of Vande Mataram, selfie points shall incorporate the Vande Mataram theme, with the lyrics made available through a downloadable video.
- Citizens shall be encouraged to upload their selfies on the Har Ghar Tiranga website to maximise public participation.

2. Plan of Action

1. The Department of Urban Local Bodies shall establish suitably designed Tiranga Selfie Points at prominent locations within their respective jurisdictions, in consultation with the locations identified by the concerned Deputy Commissioners. The selfie points shall be themed around 150 years of Vande Mataram and shall prominently feature the Har Ghar Tiranga campaign. The concerned Deputy Commissioners shall oversee and supervise the overall execution.
2. All Tiranga Rallies, Bike Rallies, Cycle Rallies and E-Bike Rallies shall be routed through such selfie points. Participants shall be encouraged to take selfies and upload them on the Har Ghar Tiranga website.
3. Anchors at all Tiranga programmes, exhibitions and Independence Day functions shall encourage participants to upload selfies on the Har Ghar Tiranga website. Deputy Commissioners shall promote the campaign through their official social media handles. The Department of Public Relations shall ensure that all Government websites prominently display the Har Ghar Tiranga website link and also branding of public places be done suitably.

3. Action to be Taken

Necessary action shall be taken by the Additional Chief Secretary, Urban Local Bodies; Director General, Information, Public Relations, Languages & Culture (DG IPRL); and all Deputy Commissioners.

Tricolour Lighting and Decoration

1. Outline of the Programme

- Tricolour lighting and decoration shall be undertaken across prominent public buildings and infrastructure to promote the spirit of patriotism.
- Government buildings, hospitals, schools, dams, bridges and other critical infrastructure may be illuminated in tricolour.
- Major public spaces shall also be illuminated to ensure maximum visibility of the Har Ghar Tiranga campaign.

2. Plan of Action

1. All Government Departments, Boards and Corporations shall ensure that all critical infrastructure, including dams, bridges, Government buildings, hospitals, schools and other assets under their administrative control, are provided with tricolour lighting and decoration.
2. To ensure maximum visibility and public engagement, marketplaces, bus stands, airports, railway stations, major roads and prominent roundabouts may also be illuminated or draped with saffron, white and green lights, transforming the landscape into a festive tribute to the nation.
3. The Department of Urban Local Bodies shall undertake tricolour lighting and decoration of common public places, markets and roundabouts in consultation with the concerned Deputy Commissioners.

3. Action to be Taken

Necessary action shall be taken by all Administrative Secretaries and all Deputy Commissioners.

Large Size Tricolour Rangoli on Vande Mataram Themes

1. Outline of the Programme

- Large-scale tricolour rangoli artworks shall be created on inspiring Vande Mataram themes to promote patriotism and public participation.
- The rangoli installations shall be executed at prominent, high-footfall public locations for maximum visibility and outreach.
- Local artists, educational institutions and Government departments shall be encouraged to participate in the initiative.

2. Plan of Action

1. All Deputy Commissioners shall identify suitable high-visibility venues for patriotic artistry and make necessary arrangements for creating large-scale tricolour rangoli based on powerful Vande Mataram themes.
2. Local artists, schools, colleges, the Women and Child Development Department and other Government departments shall be encouraged to participate in the preparation of the rangoli artworks to ensure wide public participation and community engagement.
3. The rangoli artworks shall be displayed at prominent public places to maximise public visibility and reinforce the spirit of patriotism during the Har Ghar Tiranga campaign.

3. Action to be Taken

Necessary action shall be taken by the Additional Chief Secretary, School Education Department; the Additional Chief Secretary, Women and Child Development Department; and all Deputy Commissioners.

Tiranga Demand, Procurement and Planning

1. Outline of the Programme

- Ensure adequate availability of National Flags across Haryana.
- National Flags shall be distributed to BPL families and made readily available for purchase by all other citizens.
- All National Flags shall conform to the Flag Code of India.

2. Plan of Action

1. The Department of Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs shall assess the requirement of National Flags for BPL families, procure the required quantity and distribute them through the Fair Price Shop network across the State.
2. All other citizens shall be facilitated to purchase National Flags (conforming to the Flag Code of India) through Tiranga sale counters established by Self Help Groups and other local vendors at reasonable prices.
3. All Deputy Commissioners shall identify suitable locations and provide space for Tiranga sale counters in their districts.
4. Deputy Commissioners shall coordinate with Self Help Groups, local vendors and concerned departments to ensure uninterrupted supply and adequate availability of National Flags across their districts.

3. Action to be Taken

Necessary action shall be taken by the Additional Chief Secretary, Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs Department, and all Deputy Commissioners.

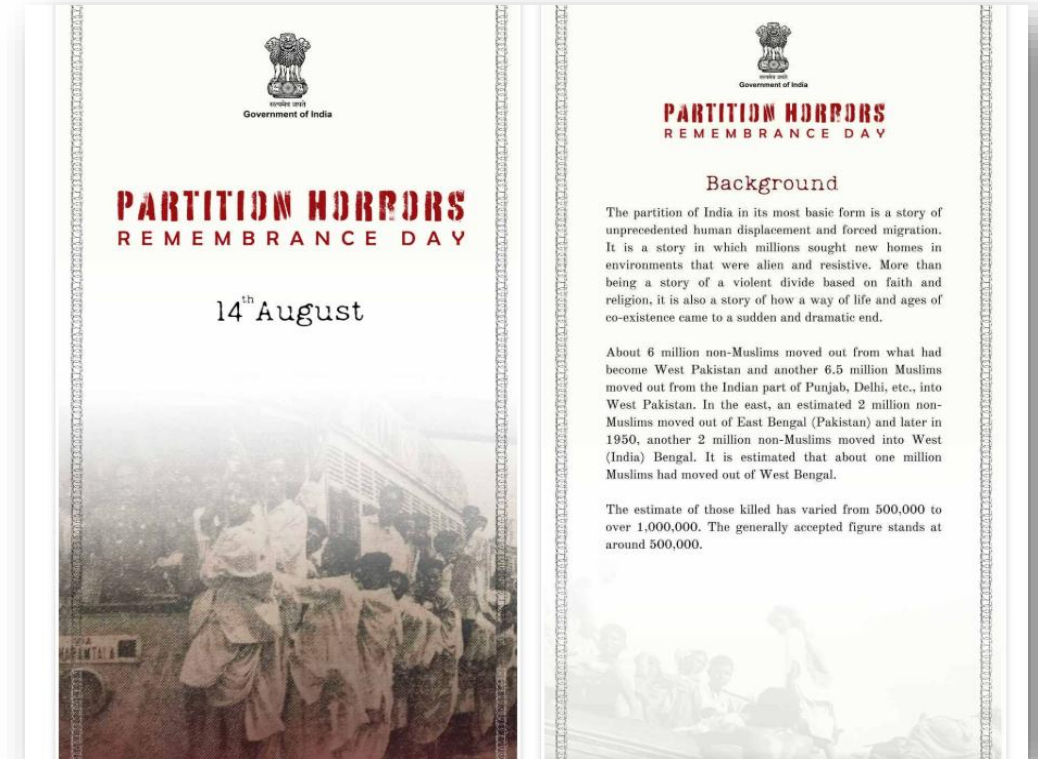

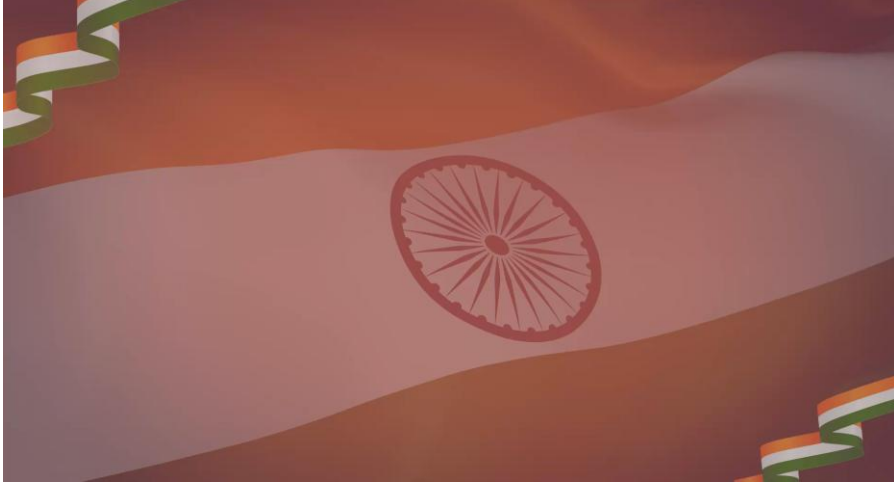

Pan-District and Panchayat Mobilization: Local administrations to organize and execute **Tiranga Bike, Cycle and E-bike rallies** across district headquarters and gram panchayat to ensure deep rural and urban outreach of the campaign.

Youth and Community Participation: Local youth clubs, sports forums, and educational institutions should be actively engaged to lead these rallies, encouraging participants to mount the national flag securely on their vehicles.

Route Mapping via Historical Landmarks: The rallies may be strategically mapped to pass through prominent local public spaces, freedom fighter memorials, and designated selfie points to maximize public visibility and community interaction.

Safety and Traffic Coordination: District police and local traffic authorities to coordinate closely to provide designated green corridors, ensuring the safety of all participants while minimizing disruption to daily public transit.

Tiranga Rallies (Procession)

- The States/UTs may organize **Tiranga Rallies with large-scale procession** featuring participants carrying the Indian National Flag in accordance with the Flag Code of India.
- **Singing Vande Mataram** encouraged at the start of the rally.
