9. Procedure of the payment & Method of keeping Accounts

Under this scheme the amount will be distributed by the O/o Director, Higher Education, Haryana, Panchkula and will be drawn by the concerned Principal of the College through their treasury.

The allocated amount will be sent through online to the college. Record of activities and expenditure will be maintained by the DDOs. Joint/Deputy/Assistant Director O/o Director Higher Education, Haryana, Panchkula will monitor the progress for effective implementation of the scheme. The grant will be distributed according to the number of students enrolled and as per requirement of the college.

10. **Time frame of the scheme**

Financial year 2023-24.

11. **Eligibility Conditions**

In charges of Women Cell are already appointed in the colleges and they select the students for different activities under this Programme.

12. **Modus Operandi of selection of beneficiaries**

Students are selected by Incharge of Women Cell on performance basis and trips will be also arranged by Incharge of Women Cell.

13. **Pattern of assistance**

Sanctions are to be issued to Govt. colleges after the strength of the students and requirement of funds are informed by the college and grants are issued in one go.

14. **Procedure of purchase, if any**

As per Govt. Norms/Rules.

CHALLENGES

There are certain challenges that need to be addressed such as maintaining safety and security of the vending machines and incinerators, timely refilling the vending machines and maintaining proper records regarding the number of pads refilled and dispensed each month.

MONITORING

- i. To overcome the above listed challenges, vending machines and incinerators shall be kept at a secure place under the direct supervision of the Nodal Officer of women cell of each government college.
- ii. A student coordinator shall be appointed to assist the Nodal Officer in carrying out the functions.
- iii. Proper monthly records shall be maintained regarding the usage of vending machines.
- iv. The records provided by the colleges shall be evaluated on monthly basis as part of the review process to find out the efficiency of the campaign.

COMMUNICATION COMPONENT

- i. Use of print media to create awareness about availability of such facilities in colleges
- ii. Use of various social media platforms to encourage girl students to increase the usage of sanitary napkins.
- iii. Colleges can play an important role in spreading the information about the availability of sanitary napkin vending machines in colleges by putting up notices, posters and banners at appropriate places.

• **For creating awareness amongst the girl students the following activities may be carried out in the colleges:-**

Survey 1	A survey shall be conducted on College Girls, using Google forms, regarding their Height, Weight and IIB to calculate prevalence of Anemia and Low BMI.
Survey 2	Qualitative Research shall be conducted on Women Empowerment and Social Health Protection through questionnaires regarding Sanitary Napkin Awareness, Uses, Availability, Benefits, Menstrual hygiene and Disorders in Villages of Haryana by Female Students studying in different Government Colleges. Each student will collect data of 10 respondents from the village using Google Form. Review Report will be prepared by analyzing the data
WEBINAR FAMOUS	BY Free nutrition advice will be given to students by famous nutritionist.

NUTRITION AND DIET AWARENESS CAMPAIGN	NUTRITION AND DIET AWARENESS CAMPAIGN will be supervised by medical expert.
BMI CALCULATION	Height , Weight and Age of every student of the college will be taken in the form of google form through which (BMI of students will be calculated
PCOS/PCOD AWARENESS	Female students should be made aware about the importance of realizing the early symptoms, prevention and cure of the hormonal syndromes with the help of gynaccologist.
TRAINING THE NODAL OFFICERS	Training of nodal officers and students medical expert on the PCOS, PCOD, menstrual hygiene ,knowledge and awareness regarding HPV screening and vaccination in reproductive age
FITNESS AND WELLNESS	Awareness among students by gynaccologist regarding role of exercise and yoga in regulation of menstrual cycle by an Yoga expert
IFA AND CALCIUM DISTRIBUTION	Distribution of supplements for 60 days among female students
QUIZ COMPETITION	A quiz competition will be organized and cash prize will be given to students
COMPETITIONS	Essay writing, declamation ,poster making
YOGA VIDEO	A challenge will be given to students, girl doing maximum yoga exercises, they will prepare a video and share with nodal officer and on any social media platform using a "#Ab Beti Hogi Nirog" "#Hygiene for Her" "#NARI DHE Hry".

15. The amount will be the drawn by the **Principal and will be disbursed and utilized for various activities mentioned in the scheme.**
16. The expenditure shall be incurred in following phases 100% in a year.
17. The entire expenditure shall be completed by **15-03-2024.**
18. Date by which the accounts should be rendered/compliance information given to the headquarter 31.03.2024. The Utilization Certificate must be sent to this office.
19. The colleges where the DD powers are allocated to Principal of a neighbouring College, that in-charge Principal will draw the amount
20. **The Officer responsible for implementing the scheme and the DDO shall strictly follow the objectives/ guidelines given below:-**
 - i. Personality development and skill enhancement to bring out latent talent among girls and impart them a minimum level of training in the craft area of interest and also to conduct specific workshops. Extension lectures ranging from subjects like bringing awareness regarding various laws and regulations, specific Women-related health and hygiene issues, theatre, painting, craft workshops will be organized with the help of well-established experts and renowned artists. Gender Sensitization Programme would be undertaken in which male students/teachers will be involved.
 - ii. Seminar, workshops and extension lectures would be conducted to usher in awareness about various laws and regulations in India and abroad pertaining to female e.g. laws pertaining to dowry, marriage, property rights, sexual harassment, female feticide. For this, eminent scholars and expert would be invited to interact and hold discussion with students.
 - iii. Another major component of the scheme would be to improve and refurbish the Girls Common Rooms in all the Govt. Colleges so as to make the ambience pleasant and healthy. Apart from repair and augmentation of these Common Rooms.

Due to covid-19, the condition to engage a lady peon under this scheme was withdrawn in the financial year 2021-22. But as per instructions No. 16/07/2015-3GS-II, dated 28.09.2021, Chief Secretary, Haryana has decided to stop all fresh

recruitment/engagement under part-I and Part -II of the Outsourcing Policy with immediate effect.

iv Principals will ensure that they will undertake all the above mentioned activities
