Minutes of the meeting held on 12.01.2023 at Haryana Bhawan, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Chief Minister, Haryana regarding hosting of the 1st Anti-Corruption Working Group Meeting planned at Gurugram on March 1-3, 2023 within the India's G-20 Presidency Year, 2023.

CS Haryana's commitment towards making India's G-20 presidency year a "Jan-Bhaagidaari" campaign and the State Government's resolve towards making the events planned in Haryana a success. Afterthat, Sh. Rahul Singh, IAS, Addl. Secretary, DoPT, Govt. of India gave a brief presentation on "Expectations from Haryana State" followed by another presentation by the Deputy Commissioner, Gurugram on the action taken so far by the district administration and State Government for preparations for the upcoming the 1st Anti-Corruption Working Group Meeting planned at Gurugram on March 1-3, 2023.

Upon detailed deliberations, the following action points emerged from the discussions:

1. The 1st Anti-Corruption Working Group Meeting will see participation from 20 member countries (G-20), 10 invitee countries and 5 multilateral organizations at the Leela Hotel, Gurugram. Overall, between 100-150 delegates will take part in the meeting. The Ministry of External Affairs will provide transportation to-and-from airport to hotel; booking of hotel for the actual meet and booking of rooms at the hotel. Remaining arrangements for the Gala Dinner (March 1, 2023 evening), excursion trip (March 4, 2023) and other excursions and cultural events are to be made by Government of Haryana.

[Action by: all concerned to note]

2. The Department of Information, Public Relations, Culture and Language, Government of Haryana (DIPRCL) will provide complete branding for the event (in and around the venue) on the theme of role of IT in anti-corruption measures in Haryana, and Haryana's culture. There will also be themed-branding from airport to the venue.

[Action by: Department of Information, Public Relations, Culture and Languages]

3. There will be four stalls at the venue. 3 stalls will be provided by Government of India (likely themes: DBT, GeM and MEITY initiatives), whereas a 4th stall will be setup by Haryana Government. It was decided that the DIPRCL will install the 4th stall along with two videos (silent, only captions and no audio) on Haryana's anti-corruption initiatives using *Parivar Pehchan Patra* and other measures.

[Action by: PS& DG Information, Public Relations and Language]

4. The Protocol Committee (*notified by the Government of Haryana vide no. Spl-5/U.S.Pro dated 27.10.2022*) and the District Administration, Gurugram were directed to visit the site and coordinate logistical arrangements with the venue authorities for a Gala Dinner of approximately 250 delegates plus senior functionaries of the Government of Haryana on evening of March 1, 2023 at A-Dot, near Leela Hotel, Gurugram.

[Action by: Protocol Committee, DC Gurugram, CP Gurugram]

5. The Tourism Department was directed to provide adequate Golf Carts for the transportation of the delegates from the meeting venue to A-Dot (Gala dinner venue). The Logistics and Transportation Committee (*notified by the Government of Haryana vide no. Spl-5/U.S.Pro dated 27.10.2022*) will make arrangements to operate the Golf Carts for seamless movement of delegates during the Gala Dinner.

[Action by PS Tourism; Transport Commissioner]

6. The Cultural Committee (*notified by the Government of Haryana vide no. Spl-5/U.S.Pro dated 27.10.2022*) and the Director, Art and Culture, Govt. of Haryana were directed to prepare a Cultural Event in consultation with MEA's EMC, ICCR and DoPT (Government of India) for the Gala Dinner to be held on 01.03.2023. This would include end-to-end arrangements for stage, artists, moderator, design, welcome in the Gala Dinner showcasing local traditions of Haryana. It was also decided that the cultural event should be approx. 30 minutes long and must not exceed 45 minutes.

[Action by: Cultural Committee, Directorate of Art and Culture, Haryana]

7. The Information, Public Relations, Culture & Languages Department was directed to design and distribute a Haryana-themed invite for the Gala Dinner highlighting the cultural attraction for all delegates. It was also decided to setup a State Government's exhibition in and around the venue of Gala dinner.

[Action by: PS Information, Public Relations, Culture & Languages Department; DG IPRL; Director Art and Culture]

8. Further, district administration, Gurugram was directed to invite senior functionaries of Government of Haryana, and Hon'ble Governor, Chief Minister, Speaker and Ministers for the Gala Dinner and appoint Liaison Officers with each dignitary for the Gala dinner.

[Action by: PS Information, Public Relations, Culture and Language; DC Gurugram]

9. To improve Jan-Bhaagidaari (public involvement) in G-20 meetings, it was decided that a state-level seminar on India's G-20 Presidency and 1st Anti-Corruption Working Group Meeting to be held at Gurugram by the Foreign Cooperation Department along with IIM Rohtak at a venue chosen in consultation with District Administration, Gurugram.
[Action by: PS Foreign Cooperation; Director, IIM, Rohtak; DC Gurugram]
10. The Department of Higher Education was directed to hold seminars, essay writing competitions and events in the month of February in Colleges & Universities on India's G-20 Presidency and 1st Anti-Corruption Working Group Meeting. The winners in these events be identified and informed to Tourism Department for interaction with delegates during the excursion planned on March 4, 2023.
[Action by: PS Higher Education; PS Tourism]
11. The Director-General Information, Public Relations and Languages was directed to encourage publishing of articles on India's G-20 Presidency and 1st Anti-Corruption Working Group Meeting by ex-bureaucrats, experts and diplomats in the run up to the event. The articles published in media be shared with the P.M.U. in DoPT, Govt. of India
[Action by DG, Information, Public Relations and Languages]
12. The District Administration Gurugram was directed to identify and spruce up selected hospitals near the venue for any unforeseen emergency, and provide round the clock medical facility at the venue along with two ALS Ambulances.
[Action by: DC Gurugram]
13. The Municipal Corporation Gurugram and CEO GMDA were directed to spruce up the venue, surrounding areas and all routes (including the excursion trip routes) for the meeting. Further, appropriate branding be installed at routes of excursion trips and to & from the airport.
[Action by: Commissioner, MC Gurugram; CEO GMDA; Administrator HSVP Gurugram]
14. It was decided that State Government may appoint Liaison Officers (HCS and IAS) for being deputed by the Protocol Committee with each delegation and senior participants of the 1st Anti-Corruption Working Group Meeting.
[Action by: SSPS (CS Office)]
15. The Protocol Committee was directed to hold at-least two special training workshops for the Nodal Officers by Feb 15, 2023.
[Action by: Protocol Committee; Resident Commissioner Haryana; Chief Protocol Officer, Gurugram]
16. The Tourism Department was directed to organize a reception party at the New Delhi airport for the delegates arriving prior to the meet, and formulate the welcome style in consultation with JS DoPT. Further, arrangements be made for aarti, pagadi, tilak along with *vanchaaridhol* while welcoming delegates at the airport and at the Gala Dinner.
[Action by: PS Tourism]
17. It was decided that a separate excursion to be planned on March 4, 2023 will be the sole responsibility of the State Government. The Tourism Department was fixed as the Nodal Department for the purpose, and the Principal Secretary Tourism will act

as the Nodal Officer for the excursion visit. After examining the options, it was decided that:

- a. Tourism Department should plan two options for delegates to choose from: (1) Sultanpur Bird Sanctuary (2) Pratapgarh Farms, Jhajjar.
- b. Tourism Department should also plan a daily activities / excursions brochure for the delegates from March 1-3, 2023 including Museo Camera, Transport Museum (Tauru) and other salient places in Gurugram.
- c. Tourism Department may plan exposure to traditional handcrafts activities like pottery, weaving, engagement of Self-Help Groups at the excursion site etc.
- d. Finally, a lunch should also be organized by the Tourism Department, as a part of the excursion.

The Logistics and Transportation Committee shall provide all transportation means to the Tourism Department for this purpose.

[Action by: PS Tourism; Transport Commissioner]

18. It was discussed that the Tourism Department may organize a Golf Tournament on Feb 9, 2023 with Ambassadors of all G-20 countries as a promotional event for the 1st Anti-Corruption Working Group Meeting at ITC Grand Golf Course (Nuh)

[Action by: PS Tourism]

19. It was decided that Foreign Cooperation Department will design, finalize and procure a memoir kit to be handed over to each delegate as a gift from Government of Haryana upon culmination of the meeting.

[Action by: PS Foreign Cooperation]

20. It was decided that in the lead up-to to the actual meeting, starting from early February, pre-event branding for the Haryana's Gurugram meet may be done at *Surajkund International Crafts Mela*.

[Action by: DG Information and Public Relations; Surajkund Mela Authority; PS Tourism]

21. It was decided that the Tourism Department and Surajkund Mela Authority should invite all G-20 countries' embassies for the Surajkund International Crafts Mela, as a pre-event branding.

[Action by: Surajkund Mela Authority; PS Tourism]

22. It was decided that an optional pre-meet cultural event on evening of February 28, 2023 may be planned at the meeting venue by the Directorate of Art and Culture in consultation with District Administration, Gurugram.

[Action by: Director Art and Culture, DC Gurugram; CP Gurugram]

23. It was desired that local administration of Gurugram may ensure that there are no other functions / marriage events etc. planned around the venue from Feb 28 to March 4, 2023; and the venues' owners may be informed timely about the meeting.

[Action by: Commissioner of Police, Gurugram]

24. The Logistics and Transportation Committee (*notified by the Government of Haryana vide no. Spl-5/U.S.Pro dated 27.10.2022*) was directed to work in close coordination with the Tourism Department and provide for all transportation arrangements on excursion day, i.e., March 4, 2023.

[Action by: Logistics and Transportation Committee; Transport Commissioner]

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
