CHAPTER-XV

EDUCATION AND CULTURE

Higher Education

Education and particularly higher education has been a critical component of bringing change and positive development in a society as well as a nation. To address the issues relating to equity, accessibility, quality higher education and infrastructure has been a prime concern for the State Government. Since the inception of State of Haryana, there were ____ colleges in the region of Rohtak. Five new government/aided colleges, besides the private colleges have been established since 1991, so that students particularly girls do not have to travel long distances. As on March 31, 2020, there are, ____ Government and ____ Government aided colleges, _____ self financed private colleges in the district. Besides, these there are _____ State, _____ Private and _____ deemed universities and ____ institutes of eminence in the district. A brief description of the Government and aided colleges in the district is given in the following paragraphs and the data related to these is given in Table ____ of Appendix.

Pt. Neki Ram Sharma Government College, Rohtak

Pt. Neki Ram Sharma Government College is situated in Rohtak town. It was established in 1934, it is accredited from AICTE and it is affiliated to Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak. It offers undergraduate, post-graduate, and professional courses. UG courses include BA, B.Com, and B.Sc (medical), B.Sc (non-medical) and Degree Honours courses. PG Courses include M.Sc Physics, Mathematics and MA in Geography. Professional courses include BCA and BBA. There is a good library and sports complex. Additional campus facilities such as canteen, computer Lab, smart class rooms, multipurpose hall, hostel facility, and online fee payment etc., are available. There are many committees such as Anti-Ragging Committee, Internal Complaints Committee, SC/ST Stipend Committee and Merit Scholarship Committee etc., for the redressal of grievances of the students as

well as teachers. On 31st March, 2018, there were _____ students including _____ girls enrolled in different streams in the college.

Government College for Women, Rohtak

The college was started as a women college in 1959 in the hostel building of the Government College for boys. With the shifting of the latter to its new building, the Government College for women occupied the main building. The college was affiliated to the Punjab University for pre-University (Arts and Science) Pre-Medical and B.A. It had 686 girls on its rolls in 1966. The college has steadily built up high traditions of scholastic excellence along with the culture of discipline and social service during the last 55 years and has carved out a distinct place in academics, cultural and sports activities. At undergraduate level, it runs classes for courses of Science, Arts and Commerce, BA (Hons) in Economics, English, Hindi, Psychology, B.Com and B.Com Hons in _____ and B.Sc(Medical) & (Non-medical), B.Sc (Home Science) Hons) B.B.A, B.C.A. and B.Sc Hons in Mathematics, Physics; MA in History, Hindi, Geography, M.com, M.Sc in computer Science and PGDCA. The college has a well-established library with more than 59,000 books along with coveted rare possession of Encyclopaedias, Research Journals and other latest periodicals. The Government College includes the facility of labs, smart class room, sports complex and multi-purpose hall. Besides these there are facility of NCC, Women Cell, e-karma Centre, Hostel for students, and online fee payment etc. There is also a placement cell in the college. It has _____ Girl students on its rolls as on March 31, 2020.

Government College Meham

The Government College Meham was established in 1987. It is located in Meham town of the District Rohtak. The Government College Meham is a premier co-education college in the area known for excellence in educational standards, various educational programs, grand faculty, rich cultural extracurricular activities and modern infrastructure. The Government College Meham is affiliated to Maharshi Dayanand University Rohtak. The College supports the highest superior standards and best practices in higher education to develop all round personality in the students. The courses imparted in the Government College include B.A, B.Sc (Non-Medical), besides these, there are department of Political Science; and Department of Public Administration. This Government College includes facility of smart class room, labs, computer lab, multipurpose auditorium, NCC, Women Cell. There is also a Library in the college for the use of students and faculty members to enhance their

knowledge and skills in the subjects of their interest. On 31st March, 2018, there were _____ students including _____ girls enrolled in different streams in the college.

Government College for Women Mokhra

The Government College for women at Mokhra was established in 2014. It is located in Mokhra village of the District Rohtak. The Government is affiliated to Maharshi Dayanand University Rohtak. This Government college is renamed after the name of Sakshi Malik, a renowned name in the field of sports particularly wrestling. The aim of the college is to fulfill the educational needs of the rural girls and empowering them through education. The Courses imparted in the Government College include B.A. in Hindi, English, History, Political Science, Geography. This Government College includes facility of smart class room, labs, computer lab, NCC, Women Cell. There is also a Library in the college for the use of students and faculty member to enhance their knowledge and skills in the subjects of their interest. As on 31 March, 2020, there were _____ seats for BA course offered by the Government College.

Government College Sampla

The Government College for women at Sampla was established in 2013. It is located in Sampla town of the District Rohtak. This is a co-educational Government college. The Government is affiliated to Maharshi Dayanand University Rohtak. The aim of the college is to fulfill the educational needs of the rural and urban students. The Courses imparted in the Government College includes B.A., B.Com and M.Com having seats of 240, 80 and 40 respectively. This Government College includes facility of smart class room, labs, computer lab, sports complex, Women Cell. There is also a Library in the college for the use of students and faculty member to enhance their knowledge and skills in the subjects of their interest. On 31st March, 2020, there were _____ students including _____ girls enrolled in different streams in the college.

Government College for Women, Sampla

The Government College for women at Sampla was established in 2000. The Sampla, on the route to Dighal via Sampla by pass, is also known as Garhi-Sampla, birth place of Sir Chhotu Ram, pioneer of social and agricultural reforms. It is located in Sampla town of the District Rohtak. The Government college is affiliated to Maharshi Dayanand University Rohtak. The aim of the college is to fulfill the educational needs of the rural girls and semi-urban girls and empowering them through education and

innovative skills. The courses imparted in the Government College include B.A., B.Com and B.Sc. The BA course includes the subjects of English, Hindi, Sanskrit, geography, Political Science, Mathematics, Economics and Physical Education. The Course of B.Sc. includes subjects of Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics. This Government College includes facility of smart class room, labs, computer lab, online fee payments, sports complex, multipurpose hall, and Women Cell. There is also a Library in the college for the use of students and faculty member to enhance their knowledge and skills in the subjects of their interest. On 31st March, 2020, there were _____ students including _____ girls enrolled in different streams in the college.

Government College Women Lakhan Majra

Government College for women was established at Lakhan Majra in the year 2008 when it felt the need of higher education for advancement and empowerment of girls. The Government college is affiliated with MDU Rohtak. There is well equipped library, computer laboratory and spacious conference hall. It prepares the girls for undergraduate courses like B.A., B.Com, B.Sc. There is also a Library in the college for the use of students and faculty members to enhance their knowledge and skills in the subjects of their interest. As on 31 March, 2020, there were _____ students enrolled in the various disciplines in the Government college.

Gaur Brahm Degree College Rohtak

Gaur Brahman Vidya Pracharini Sabha (Regd.) headed by Late Sh. Pt. Bhagwat Dayal Sharma, the first chief Minister of Haryana. To perpetuate the memory and carry forward the mission, the devout established in 1919, the 'Gaur Brahman Vidya Pracharini Sabha' with the main objectives of imparting education to this area. The guiding principles of Sabha, all through the years, have been the assimilation of the fundamental values of Indian culture blended with new scientific thoughts and technology suited to changing modern times. The movement took practical shape with the establishment of the Gaur Brahman Central High School, Rohtak in a rented building. Gaur Braham College of Education Rohtak

This Government College, situated on Panipat-Gohana highway, with an area of 36 acres, was established in July, 1999. There were 125 students in the first session of this college. It prepares the students for degree courses in Arts and Commerce. It has 688 students including 390 boys and 298 girls on its rolls as in March, 2011. The college has the facility of a well equipped library having 5816 books, two computer laboratories equipped with 50 computers, sports ground, Placement Cell, Women Cell, Legal Literacy Cell, N.S.S and N.C.C. units for the welfare of students. Students of the college are also associated with student clubs like Red Ribbon Club, Cultural Club, and Road Safety Awareness Club in the college for spreading the awareness and for welfare of the community. Government College, Jassia

This Government College was started in 2013 with two streams i.e. Arts and Commerce, with an intake of 160 seats and 80 seats respectively. This college is situated at Jassia village. It caters the education needs of the rural students with the motive to prepare the students to compete the urban students at par. This is a co-educational college. The Graduate level course of B.A includes the subjects of History, Economics, Political Science, Geography, Psychology, English, Hindi, Mathematics besides the course of B.Com are being taught. The college has the facility of a well equipped library, Labs, smart class rooms, sports complex, multipurpose hall, women cell, Hostel for girls, NCC and online fee payment facility etc. As on 31st March, 2020, there were _____ students for the BA course and _____ students for the B.Com course. There were total _____ students including _____ girls enrolled in different streams in the college.

All India Jat Heroes Memorial College Rohtak

This institution was established in 1944 by raising the All India Jat heroes memorial Anglo-Sanskrit High School, Rohtak to the status of Degree College. A teacher training college, namely Chhotu Ram College of Education, Rohtak was established in 1957. The College is being run by the Jat Education Society which is a registered body. It was affiliated to the Punjab University for Pre-University (Art, Science and Agriculture) Pre-medical, pre-engineering , B.A. B.Sc. It had a library having 6600 books. It had 1000 students including 15 girls on its rolls in 1966. Now it is affiliated with Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak. All India Jat Heroes Memorial College offers the BA, B.Sc., B. Com, BCA and BBA courses at the undergraduate level. The BA, B.Sc. and B.Com. courses are added courses and the BCA and BBA courses are self-financed courses. The college also offers the M.Sc., MA and M.Com. courses at the post graduate level. The college has the facility of a well equipped library, Labs, sports complex, multipurpose hall, women cell, NCC and online fee payment facility etc. On 31st March, 2020, there were _____ students including _____ girls enrolled in different streams in the college.

Maharani Kishori Jat Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Rohtak

Maharani Kishori Jat Kanya Mahavidyalaya is situated in Rohtak. It was established in 1988, MKJKC is a Private college. The college is accredited by UGC, NAAC. The College is being run by the Jat Education Society which is a registered body. Maharani Kishori Jat Kanya Mahavidyalaya offers 11 courses across 6 streams, namely Commerce and Banking, Science, Vocational, Physical Education, Arts. Popular degrees offered at Maharani Kishori Jat Kanya Mahavidyalaya include BSc, BA, B.P.Ed, B.Com, MA. Besides a robust teaching pedagogy, Maharani Kishori Jat Kanya Mahavidyalaya is also a leader in research and innovation. Focus is given to activities beyond academics at Maharani Kishori Jat Kanya Mahavidyalaya, which is evident from its infrastructure, extracurricular activities and national & international collaborations. The placement at Maharani Kishori Jat Kanya Mahavidyalaya is varied, with recruitment options both in corporates and public sector as well as entrepreneurship.
